POSITION SUMMARY: Sorts, weighs, washes and folds linen and resident clothing. Attends to resident

admissions/discharges. Carries out labelling, mending and alterations.

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Sorts and weighs soiled linen and resident clothing.

- 2. Loads and unloads washers of up to 65 pounds capacity.
- 3. Loads wet laundry into hand trucks and into dryer.
- 4. Operates washers and dryers according to programmed cycles.
- 5. Folds and separates laundry and loads onto appropriate linen cart.
- 6. Ensures adequate supply of clean linen is available for all areas of the Lodge.
- 7. Cleans laundry room and equipment. Reports any maintenance problems to the Manager.
- 8. Advises Seamstress of worn linen and resident clothing.
- 9. Requires thorough knowledge of equipment, procedures and chemicals used in the laundry process.
- 10. Requires long periods of standing on cement floor and working in a hot, noisy environment.
- 11. Trains and orientates new laundry washer/workers as assigned.
- 12. Other duties as assigned.

- 2. Previous experience in laundry operations in health care, institutional or hospitality settings.
