POSITION OVERVIEW

Under the supervision of the Environmental Services Manager, the Maintenance Worker performs minor and routine repairs to building, property, and equipment as well as checks emergency systems to ensure safety of residents.

This is a permanent, part-time, relief/on-call position. Hours of work may vary and scheduled hours each week are not guaranteed. The successful candidates must be available to work weekdays, evenings, weekends and statutory holidays, and must be available on short notice for call-in shifts.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Completion of high school (Grade 12) or equivalent
- Previous experience in maintenance of a health facility, factory or plant
- Demonstrated mechanical aptitude
- Class G Driver's Licence with a driver's abstract that is clean and free of any infractions, and access to a vehicle
- Current Criminal Record Check with a Vulnerable Sector Screening that is satisfactory to Strathmere Lodge/Middlesex County
- Completion of TB testing (a two-step TB test dated within the last 12 months or a one-step TB test dated within the last 12 months will be accepted if a two-step TB test was previously completed)

POSITION SUMMARY:

Performs minor and routine repairs to building, property, and equipment. Checks emergency systems to ensure safety of residents.

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Conducts, tests and records daily inspection of heating and ventilation units, pumps, air compressor, boilers and softeners, refrigerator and units and makes adjustments as required.
2. Performs minor and routine repairs and adjustments on equipment such as servicing humidifiers, repairing plugs, cranks, cords, wheelchairs, polishers and scrubbers, treating grease traps, lubricating dishwasher, beds, washer and dryer, etc.
3. Performs minor and routine repairs to building and property such as replacing pumps, plugs, switches, lights and ballasts, painting, repairing screens, lubricating pumps and fans, clearing blocked sewer lines, painting etc.
4. Maintains lawns and gardens in summer and removes snow from sidewalks in winter.
5. Checks fire doors, locks outside doors and checks furniture in sitting rooms for fire hazards.
6. Checks and tests emergency generator.
7. Paints interior of building.
8. Maintains and operates Lodge Bus to transport residents.
9. Required to work independently.
10. Other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Grade 12.
2. Previous experience in maintenance of a health facility, factory or plant.
3. Demonstrated mechanical aptitude.
4. Ability to communicate, both orally and in writing, to various levels of the organization.
5. Ability to work effectively both independently and as part of a team.
6. Class “G” Driver’s Licence with a driver’s abstract that is clean and free of any infractions, and access to a vehicle.
7. Must provide a Current Criminal Record Check with a Vulnerable Sector Screening.
8. Must provide a two-step TB skin test (dated within 1 year).
