Overview of the Position

The Road Worker V (Licensed Mechanic) maintains and repairs County vehicles and equipment; performs safety checks on dump vehicles; assesses repair costs; installs snow removal equipment; fabricates components; and provides guidance to equipment operators in the maintenance and repair of equipment.

- Performs mechanical fitness checks on all County dump vehicles in conformance with the County's Motor Vehicle Inspection Station Licence, and makes repairs as required.
- In conjunction with the General Superintendent and Shop Foreman reviews the cost effectiveness of in-house vs contract repairs and assist with specifications of new equipment.
- Performs non-warranty repairs on graders, backhoes, front end loaders, dump vehicles, trucks, pick-ups, pumps, sand boxes, gravel stackers, trailers, etc.
- Adapts, rebuilds, installs, and removes County snow removal and ice control equipment.
- Maintains, repairs and installs hydraulic systems and where required, fabricates and installs hydraulic systems to suit road construction and maintenance needs.
- Installs and repairs safety light systems on all County vehicles.
- Fabricates steel components for road construction and maintenance requirements, such as culvert modifications, catch basin frame and grates, CSP rat traps, non-structural bridge repairs, hitches, and repairs and strengthens plough equipment.
- Performs diagnostic testing on vehicles.
