

Clark Wright Conservation Area

This 20 hectare site, donated by Mr. Clark Wright, includes nature trails through lands that have been reforested over the past 40 years. The conservation area is a diverse site with forest, meadow, wetlands and ponds, making it an excellent place for bird watching. Many of the trees were planted as part of the Memorial Forest program of the St. Clair Region Conservation Foundation.
