

The Joany's Woods Management area is owned by Thomas Doherty and managed by the Ausable Bayfield Conservation Authority to protect and maintain the unique natural environment. This area has many Carolinian plants and animals that are considered provincially and nationally rare. Poison ivy is prolific at Joany's Woods so be aware of glossy leaves arranged in threes. You can travel through Joany's Woods on two trails. The Lookout Trail is a nice walk with a few gentle slopes. Your adventure will take you through a variety of ecosystems - from swamps to plantations and everything in between. The Tulip Tree Trail is more demanding with many steep slopes. The climb is well worth it as you will experience a Carolinian forest at its best.
