

Longwoods Road Conservation Area 11

Longwoods Road Conservation Area is a 63 hectare park located west of London on County Road 2 (Longwoods Road). This park was the provincial winner of Attractions Canada 2002 'Developed Outdoor Site'.

Several foot trails totalling 6.5 km in length take walkers through the forested section of the conservation area and along the ravines of Mill Stream. Birding is a popular activity along the trails. The boardwalk along the Muncey Trail provides great views of a significant wetland.

Distance 5 km

Difficulty Easy to moderate

Trail Use Two wheelchair accessible trails, walking, pets on leashes, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing (not groomed)

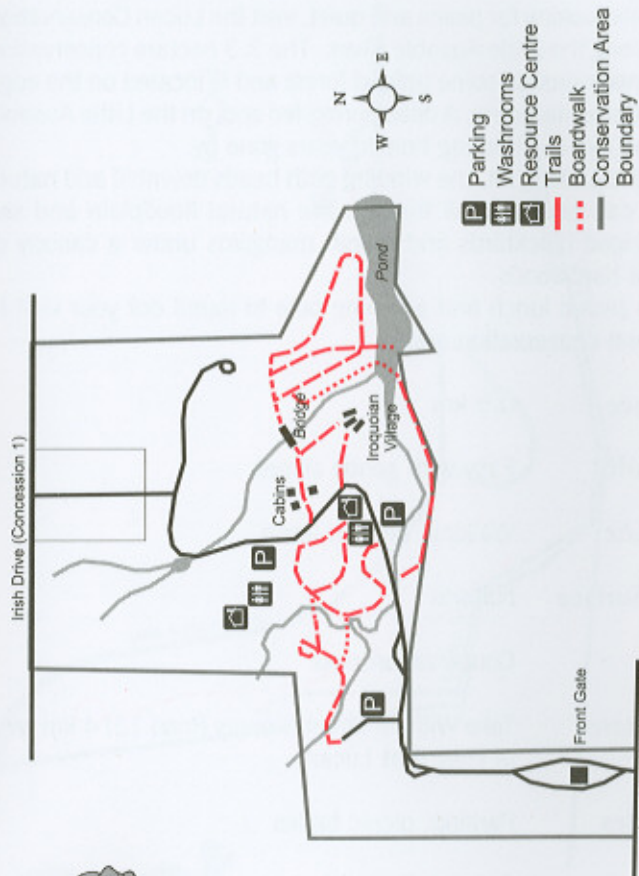
Trail Surface Natural, chip and dust, boardwalks, bridges, stairs

Directions From Delaware go west on County Road 2. Look for 8348 Longwoods Road, approximately 32 km west of London, 6.5 km west of Delaware and 10 km east of Melbourne.

Facilities Ska-Nah-Doht Iroquoian Village and Museum, Resource Centre, picnic pavilion, group camping areas, washrooms, suspension bridge, picnic areas, barbecues, snowshoe rentals, school and youth group programs, parking, water tap
