

## Lucan Conservation Area

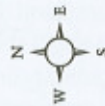

If you are looking for peace and quiet, visit the Lucan Conservation Area along the Little Ausable River. The 3.3 hectare conservation area encompasses some upland forest and is located on the edge of the Carolinian zone. A deep spring-fed spot on the Little Ausable was the local swimming hole in years gone by.

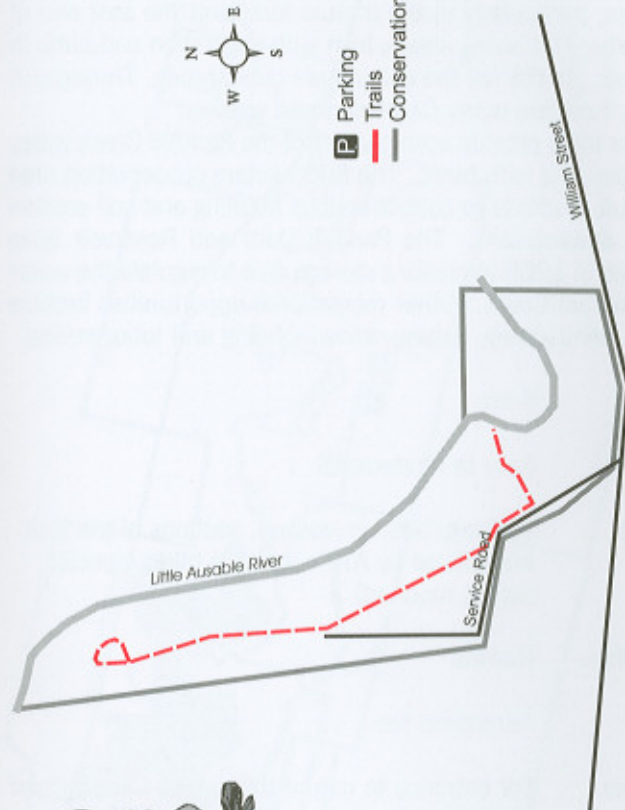
From the parking lot, the winding path heads downhill and nature lovers can take a stroll through the natural floodplain and see red-winged blackbirds and marsh marigolds under a canopy of mature hardwoods.

Take a picnic lunch and a fishing pole to round out your visit to this rural conservation area.
