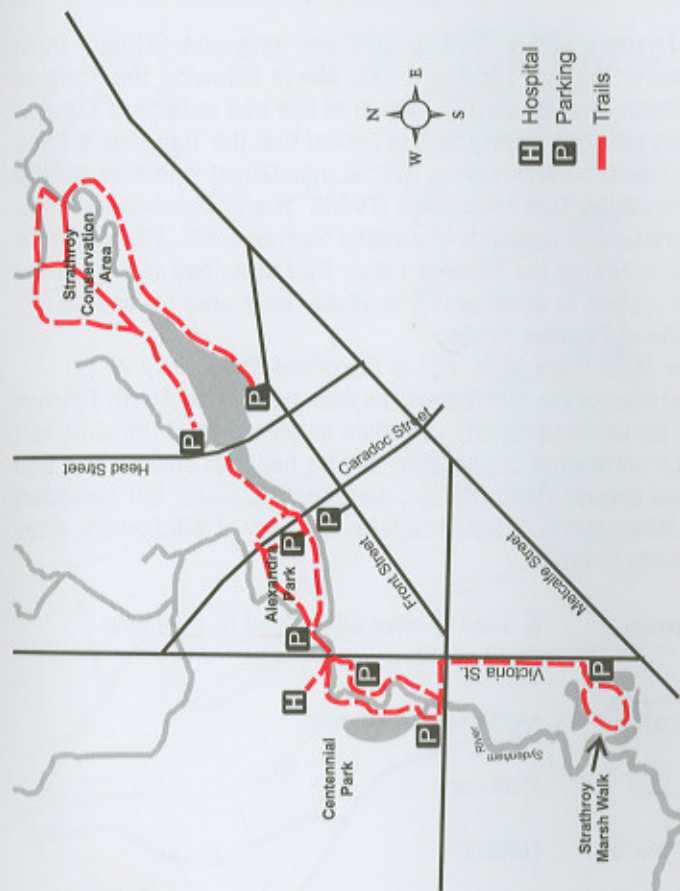


Strathroy River Walk

The Strathroy River Walk trail includes walking trails through Conservation Areas and township green space. The trails in the Strathroy Conservation Area wind through a floodplain forest that is an excellent place for bird watching and enjoying the wild flowers. From the conservation area, the trail follows the Sydenham River through the township's green space, a mix of passive and active parkland along the shores of the Sydenham River. The parks are a great place to take in a ball game, view flower gardens and the memorial forest, and enjoy the playground equipment or skateboard facility. The trail system ends at the Strathroy Marsh Walk where the trail loops through a constructed wetland.

Distance	Strathroy River Walk = 5.5 km Strathroy Conservation Area = 2.8 km

Trail Use	Walking, pets on leashes, cross-country skiing (not groomed), snowshoeing
Trail Surface	Natural, lawn, chip and dust, boardwalk
