







RESIDENTS IDENTIFYING AS VISIBLE MINORITY (2021)




IMMIGRATION, PREV. 10 YRS (% POP.)



% OF POP. WITH NO KNOWLEDGE OF ENGLISH OR FRENCH











MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME BY HOUSEHOLD TYPE

% OF OCCUPIED DWELLINGS OWNED VS. NOT OWNED (RENTED)




FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN - COUPLE AND SINGLE PARENT


HIGHEST LEVEL OF EDUCATION COMPLETED - COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX (2021)








PERCENTAGE OF HOUSEHOLD INCOME FROM GOV. TRANSFER PAYMENTS


