Key Enhancements for 2026



EarlyON Program Expansion - Evening and Saturday Access

Expanded EarlyON programming to improve accessibility and support for working families.



Library System Leadership Restoration

Reinstatement of the Manager of Library Services to modernize system-wide service delivery.



Community Transportation Program Extension

Five-year extension of Middlesex County Connect under provincial implementation funding.



Corporate Records Digitization

Temporary Records Assistant to accelerate corporate readiness for the new Governance & Administration Centre.



Economic Development & CISP Launch

Funding to support local municipal Community Improvement Plans and growth initiatives.



Community Well-Being Support Enhancements


Strengthened supports for vulnerable populations through expanded Human Services programming.



2026 Capital Program



Transportation Infrastructure

- More than 80% of Capital investment directed to transportation infrastructure:
 - 56.5km of roadwork
 - 4 structures
- Reflects the size of County network and the importance of safe, reliable roads, bridges and structures.
- Investment Goal: to protect service levels today, prevent costly backlogs tomorrow, and responsibly prepare for upcoming bridge and infrastructure rehabilitation.

County Property Tax

For a typical residential property, the County portion of the tax bill increases by \$17.89 per \$100,000 of assessed value in 2026. This increase supports essential County services, infrastructure maintenance, and targeted community investments. Actual property taxes will vary based on property assessment and local municipal and education tax rates.
