### GET INVOLVED IN A MIDDLESEX COUNTY BOARD OR COMMITTEE

Volunteering on a board or committee is a great way to share your ideas, expertise and enthusiasm with your local government. As a member, you will be able to provide advice to County Council and staff, and contribute to the development of policies, programs and initiatives that will help enhance Middlesex County. Whatever your area of interest there is a board or committee that would benefit from your input and involvement.

Residents of Middlesex County are encouraged to apply for the following Boards or Committees:

#### **Middlesex Accessibility Advisory Committee (5 Vacancies)**

The main purposes and activities of the Middlesex Accessibility Advisory Committee are to advise County Council on the preparation, implementation and effectiveness of its annual accessibility plan; to review site plans of and advise on accessibility issues relating to identified buildings within the County and to advise County Council on other accessibility related issues within the County. Working hand in hand with County Council, the Advisory committee strives to provide vision and direction to both staff and County Council regarding the removal of barriers that exist within municipal services, practices and programs. The Middlesex Accessibility Advisory Committee has the ability to have a profound impact on people with disabilities and the community as a whole within the County.

#### **Middlesex County Library Board (3 Vacancies)**

Middlesex County Library Board is a Local Board established by County Council to provide progressive, collective leadership and direction to the Library and to set the framework for the operating context. The Library Board exercises its authority under the *Public Libraries Act* and its amendments. All appointed trustees are responsible for many important roles, including but not limited to advocacy, protecting and advancing the interests of the broader community by advising County Council and Library CEO in the policies, promotion and development of the 15-branch Library system. Trustees are required to attend all meetings, represent the library at community events, stay informed about the library and participate fully in the Board's discussions and decision-making process. The three members serve a 4-year term. Meetings are held on the second Tuesday of the month at 10:30 am in the Middlesex County Building at 399 Ridout Street North, London.
