MIDDLESEX COUNTY DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY - UPDATE

All Middlesex County roads have been reopened following 48 hours of heavy rainfall and significant flooding in some regions of the County. While all County roads have been reopened, the County continues to urge the public to use caution while travelling, as there are a number of shoulder washouts along County highways in all regions. County roads crews will be working today to address the damage caused.

The flooding has also impacted a number of local roads across the County. Motorists should consult their local municipal website for details on the status of local roads.
